Venue and Transportation



The COEX is a world-class convention center located at the center of the Gangnam district of Seoul. Over 200 exhibitions, conventions, and special events are held at the COEX every year. Gangnam is a newly developed area of residence, business, and entertainment. It is filled with hotels of various levels, shopping centers, restaurants, and pubs, all of which are located within walking distance from the COEX. Seoul is safe even at night. Its metro/subway system is excellent, thereby making it convenient to reach tourist destinations located downtown from the Gangnam district.

The conference's participants from abroad will mostly enter Korea through Incheon International Airport (ICN). ICN is located 52km west of downtown Seoul. The most convenient way to reach the COEX and sub hotels from the airport is to take the limousine bus, which takes approximately 1 hour.
