Venue and Transportation

It is filled with hotels of various levels, shopping centers, restaurants, and pubs, all of which are located within walking distance from the COEX. Seoul is safe even at night. Its metro/subway system is excellent, thereby making it convenient to reach tourist destinations located downtown from the Gangnam district.

The conference's participants from abroad will mostly enter Korea through Incheon International Airport (ICN). ICN is located 52km west of downtown Seoul. The most convenient way to reach the COEX and sub hotels from the airport is to take the limousine bus, which takes approximately 1 hour.
